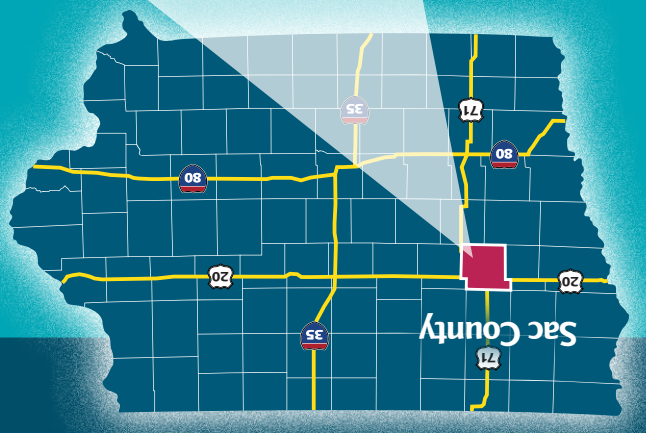
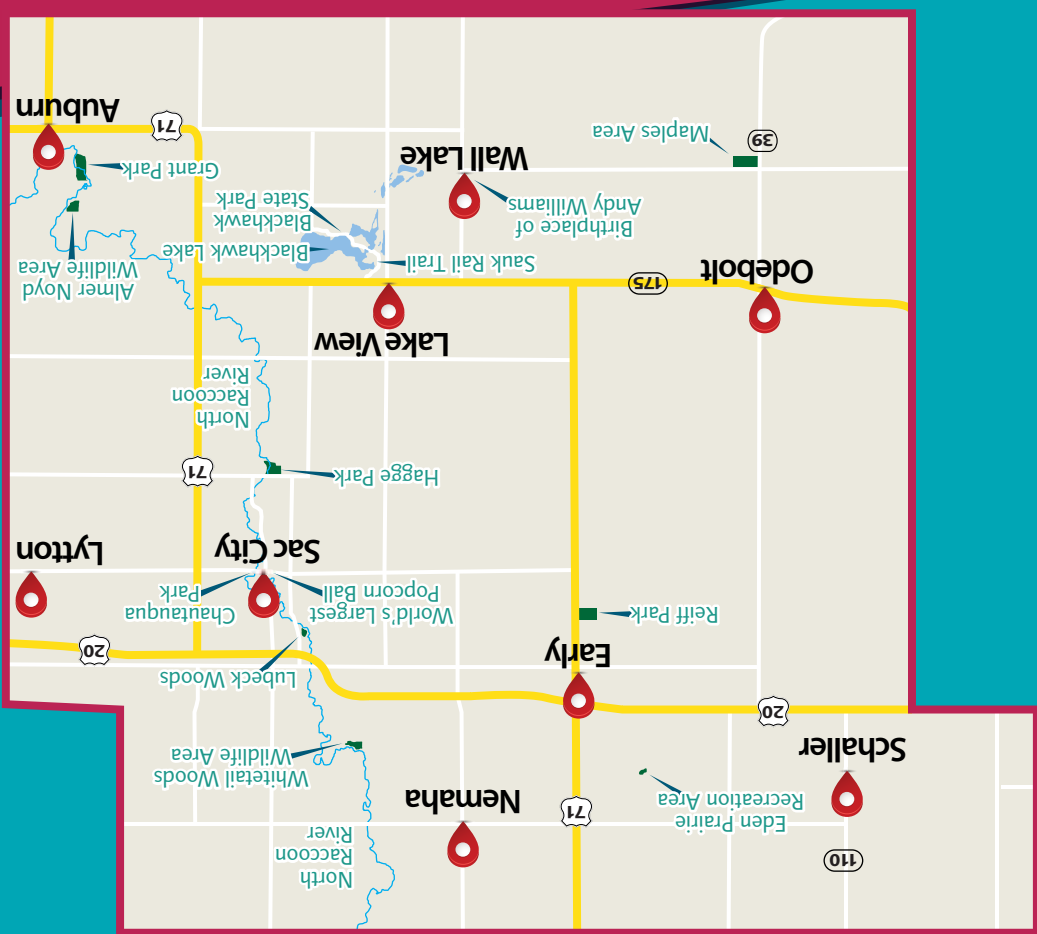

Raccoon River

The North Raccoon River is known as a place of solitude and good fishing, canoeing, kayaking, and tubing. At its upper navigable reaches in Sac County, the river flows through a heavily glaciated area with unique scenery including rapids and rock dams.

Has canoe access points, campgrounds, hard surface boat ramp, fishing access, restrooms, and drinking water access near river.

Black Hawk Lake

Lake View has a natural spring fed lake surrounded by rock boulders. Black Hawk Lake offers 957 acres of recreation and is the southern most glacial lake in the United States.

Sauk Rail Trail

The Sauk Rail Trail is a 33 mile concrete/asphalt multi-use recreational trail and is the first trail in the state of Iowa to connect two state parks – Black Hawk Lake State Park and Swan Lake State Park. Both state parks have lakes and camping facilities.

There are several rest stops along the way – benches, shelters, bars, and restaurants.

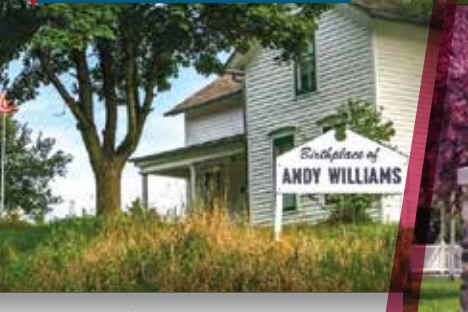

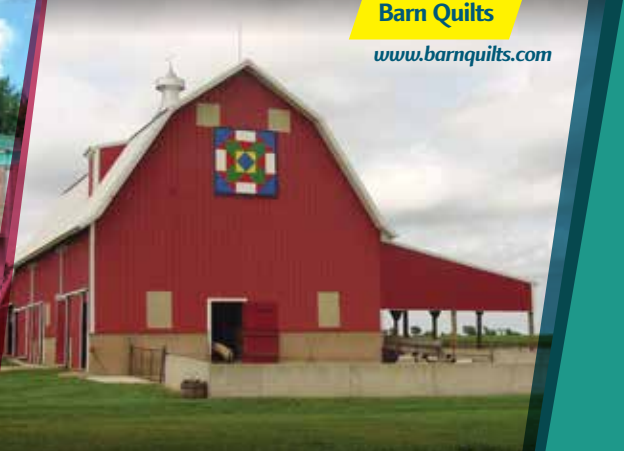
